

I must start with a huge apology to anyone who has had problems with the April invoice. We have





There have been many changes to individual bookings due to children being booked out on holiday and the bank holiday. There has been an annual price increase, plus we had a complete new funding system and term to allocate funding against children's names.

Also we have changed to a complete new software system which we have been learning to use. We thought we had it already to run the invoices and indeed we had inputted the information correctly. BUT... The system software was built by Connect and somewhere in the 'building of the system' certain elements had not been ticked/flagged. This caused all the funding hours and 50% holiday discounts to conflict and basically calculate the invoices incorrectly and in a way that has taken us days to understand.

Having worked with the Connect software specialist we now hope we have resolved these problems. We understand that you may have paid already, these monies already paid will show on you next invoice as a credit or debit depending.

If you have not yet made any payments we want to assure you we understand if they are not paid by the 14 days as long as they reach us by April 24th.

Again I can only apologise and thank you for bearing with us during this transition.

On a more positive note, We are getting there!! And we are sure once these problems are ironed out it will all work well for us and you.





Please remember to check for updates regarding your child on your Parent Zone App and please post us some pictures of your child's homelife. It helps us to feel closer to your child if we can share moments with them talking about their photo of them with their cat or on their home swing!

Optimistically - As the summer approaches can we remind you that you must put suncream on your child before they arrive at nursery and that your child always needs a bag of spare clothes here for those little accidents they have with water, yogurts, paint...



<u>Toys from home</u> Toys or other objects from the family home should not be brought into the nursery.



Please discourage your child from bringing in toys from home as they do get picked up by other children, broken or lost and we haven't got time to look for them. We do accept comforters are often important for transition to help support children's emotional security when they are very young especially in the baby room.
